### **Press Release**

#### **Investigation into the market for the supply of fur animal food in the Greek territory**

The Hellenic Competition Commission (hereinafter the “HCC”) will convene on January 28<sup>th</sup>, 2020 based on the related Statement of Objection, in order to decide whether there is a breach of Article 2 L. 3959/2011 by MAVIZ SA following a complaint by A. K.

According to the Statement of Objections, MAVIZ’s behavior did not amount to an abuse under Article 2 L. 3959/2011 and there is no need for further action by the HCC in the present case with respect to the aforementioned company under Article 102 TFEU.

**It should be noted that the Opinion is not binding on the HCC, which will decide on the basis of the available facts and the views of the parties.**
